CALEDONIA-Vivian A. Clark (nee: Jones) passed away peacefully at her residence on May 31, 2025 at the age of 91. She was born November 13, 1933 in Racine, WI to E. F. (Edward) and Emma (nee: Devert) Jones, who were from Ladd, IL. She was a graduate of Park High School “Class of 1951”. She worked as a key punch operator for several years.
